### FLYIN' BOB AND ESED APPLICATION FOR 2024-2025 STUDENT ATTENDANCE PROJECTS

Last October, the Victoria Gold Yukon Student Encouragement Society's (Society) *Every Student, Every Day* initiative supported Flyin' Bob, who in partnership with the Yukon Arts Centre and Northwestel Hanging Sky Tour, presented introductory circus workshops in nine communities throughout the territory.

Through juggling, clowning, unicycling, acrobatics, wire walking, audience participation, comedy and character, Flyin' Bob's instruction stresses the importance of physical activity, concentration, peer support, community and the value of failure as well as success. According to Flyin' Bob's web site, "students learn the rewards and consequences of taking risks and taking responsibility for their own actions."

"*Every Student, Every Day* was excited to co-present Flyin' Bob and help bring his unique skills and philosophy of learning to Yukon schools," says Society President Tara Christie.

During his 12 days in the territory, Flyin' Bob gave both workshops and performances in schools in Watson Lake, Teslin, Carcross, Haines Junction, Dawson City, Mayo, Pelly Crossing, Faro and Carmacks, with financial support from *Every Student, Every Day*.

Established in 2012, *Every Student, Every Day* raises awareness and funds to directly support projects designed and implemented by Yukon educators, schools, school councils, Yukon First Nations and community organizations to help increase student engagement and attendance in the classroom. Since its establishment, *Every Student, Every Day* has raised and distributed over \$1.85 million and benefited over 200 projects.

The property is accessible by road year-round and is connected to Yukon Energy Corp's electrical grid. The mine is a significant contributor to the Yukon economy employing 350-400 people.
