VICTORIA GOLD/NND CBA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM DEADLINE

As part of the *Comprehensive Cooperation and Benefits Agreement* (CBA), signed by Victoria Gold and the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun (FNNND) in October 2011, a scholarship program was established in 2012 and is mutually implemented to help support FNNND citizens attending full-time university, college or trades and technical courses.

This initiative, the **Victoria Gold/NND CBA Scholarship Program**, accepts applications twice a year; in August for the Fall school semester and in November for the Winter school semester.

The **upcoming scholarship program application deadline is August 19, 2022** and scholarships will be awarded on September 9.

Maggie Wallingham-Schultz received a Victoria Gold/NND CBA Scholarship earlier this year as she pursues her Bachelor of Science in Biology at the University of Calgary.

“The Victoria Gold-NND scholarship helped me immensely as it allowed me to focus solely on my studies instead of worrying about the financial aspects of my post-secondary education,” says Maggie. “After I finish my undergraduate degree, I plan to apply for medical school.”

Since its creation, the Victoria Gold/NND CBA Scholarship Program has provided over 135 scholarships to FNNND citizens for a total disbursement over \$130,000.

“I would tell other FNNND citizens to follow their dreams and step out of their comfort zones to try something new,” continues Maggie. “Learn, explore and find your passion.”
